Only Athletes on this list are allowed to compete.
- Participants:** The competition will be executed according to the currently valid regulations of Austria's Federal Ministry of Health. Due to the maximum number of 500 people, as well as the organisational restrictions concerning keeping distance the competition will be held as an invitational meeting. All participants confirm their compliance with these regulations with their signature at the registration office.
- Spectators:** On the stands the spectators have to use the seats that are assigned to them. Under all circumstances the regulations concerning keeping distance must be considered. Because there is a maximum number of people who are allowed to enter the stadium and due to Covid-19-rules spectators should confirm their attendance of the event with their signature at the registration office. Entry is free of charge for spectators but it will be denied after maximum number is reached.
- Entry fee:** € 10,- for each competition in the main-program (has to be paid in cash at the registration desk)
€ 5,- for each competition in the pre-program (has to be paid in cash at the registration desk)
- Entry check:** All athletes have to come to the registration desk on competition day at least 60min before the start of their event.
- General regulations:** The competition will take place according to the regulations of World Athletics and with the permission of Austrian Athletics. The competition equipment will be weighed and measured at the stadium. The organizers don't assume any responsibility for any kinds of accidents or damage of objects that may occur.
- Price money:** The five best performances according to the World Athletics scoring tables will be rewarded with price money:
1.) 500€ - 2.) 400€ - 3.) 300€ - 4.) 200€ - 5.) 100€

Anti-Doping:

By participating, the athletes commit themselves to comply with the anti-doping regulations of the Anti-Doping Federal Act 2007 as well as the relevant regulations of Austrian Athletics and World Athletics (in particular statutes, NWB, Book of Rules, etc.).

Note on reporting:

To document and report this Austrian Athletics event, pictures and films will be taken. When visiting the event, visitors grant Austrian Athletics or the respective medium the right to use recordings - pictures and videos - in any technical form free of charge for media reports and announcements. If you do not want to be in the picture, please inform the photographer directly.

DSGVO instructions:

Information on the processing of personal data at this Austrian Athletics event.

Responsible

Austrian Athletics, 1040 Vienna, Prinz Eugen-Str. 12, office@oelv.at is responsible for the processing of personal data of participants in this athletics event.

Processing purposes

Purposes are preparation and execution of the event - e.g. administration of the registration system, preparation and maintenance of starting and participant lists, evaluation of the services for the preparation of a list of results, publication of results and reports, press and public relations.

Legal basis

The basis for these processing activities are mainly contract performance in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. b DSGVO, legal obligations in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. c DSGVO (e.g. BAO, state laws on tax law) as well as in some cases our legitimate interest in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f DSGVO.

Legitimate interests

Our legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f DSGVO lie in enabling the event to take place within the limits of our statutory tasks and purposes as an association. Within the scope of our legitimate interest, we document the event with photos and reports, for example, and publish them on our website. Processing in the legitimate interest is only carried out after careful consideration of the interests of the persons affected by the processing. We comply with all data protection-related regulations and ensure that the rights and interests of the persons concerned are respected. Should you be of the opinion that your rights and/or interests have been violated or restricted by the data processing carried out by us, please inform us - we will immediately stop further processing if possible.

Recipients or categories of recipients

For the purposes described above, we may pass on data of the persons concerned to commissioned third parties who work for us in the fulfilment of these purposes (IT service providers, media services and media companies for the fulfilment of press and public relations work, timekeeping companies, etc.). Data will not be transferred to third countries or international organisations.

Duration of storage/criteria for determining the duration

We store and process the data for the period of time that results from the respective processing method. We take care to store data only for periods of time necessary for the fulfilment of the purposes.

Rights of data subjects

You are entitled to the rights of information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, in certain cases a right to object to processing, as well as the right to data transferability. You have the right to object to processing in your legitimate interest in accordance with Art. 21 Paragraph 1 DSGVO. In this case, we will stop processing unless there are reasons worthy of protection for further processing on our part, or the processing is necessary for the exercise, assertion and defence of legal claims. You have the right to complain to the Austrian Data Protection Authority.
